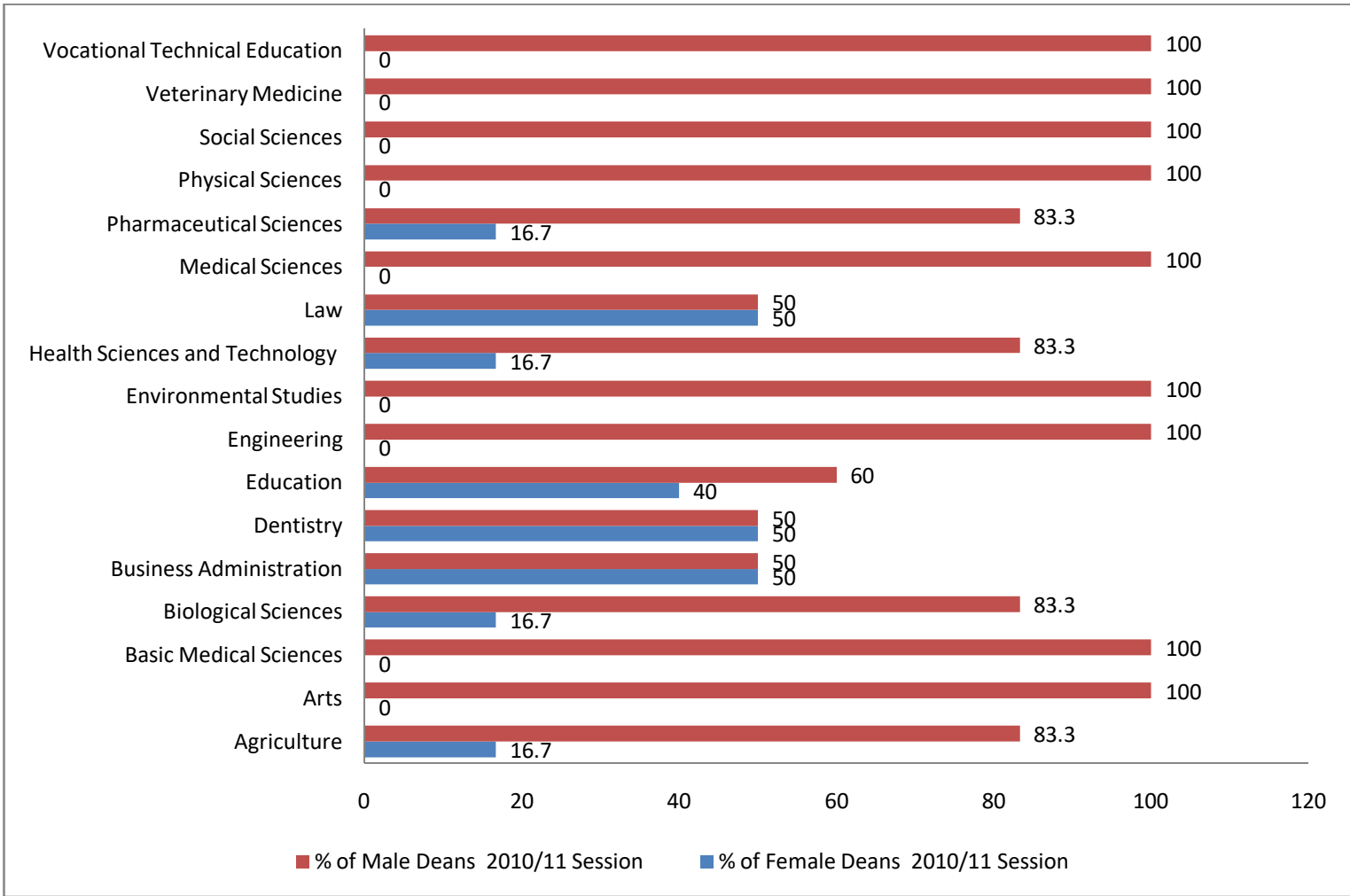

- No Faculty based in the Nsukka campus of the University has elected a female Dean more than once since the 2010/2011 session



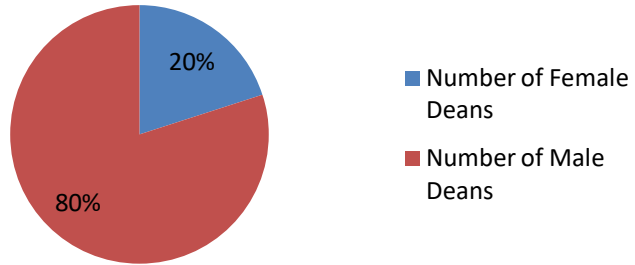

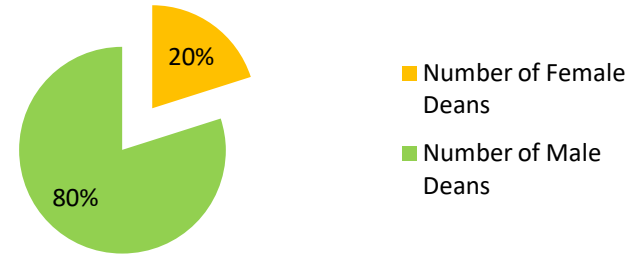

- Although this data covered from the 2010/2011 session, there is a high likelihood that the situation is worse if the record is dated back

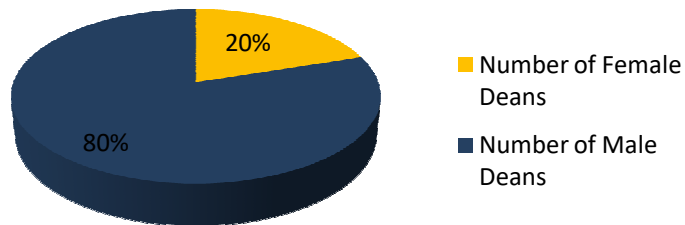

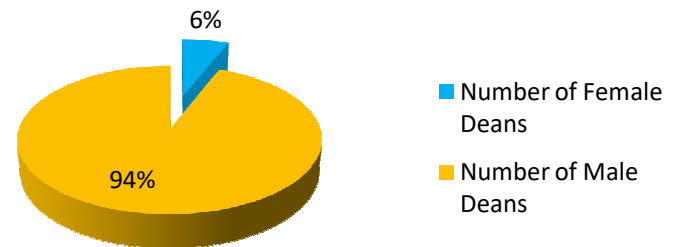
### 12/13 to 13/14 session



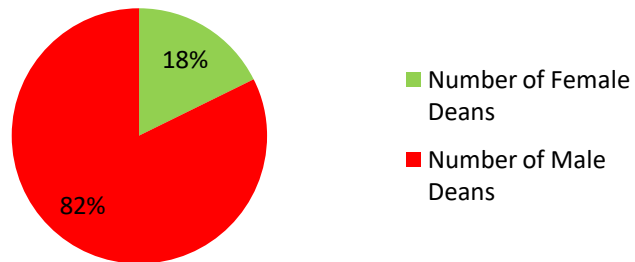
### 14/15 to 15/16 session



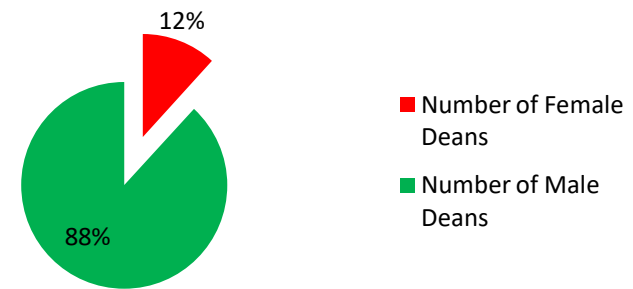

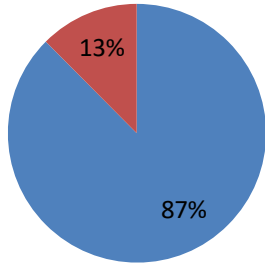

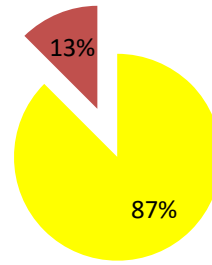

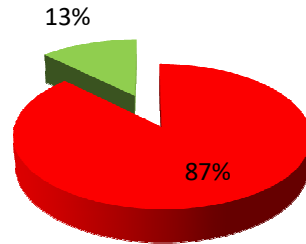

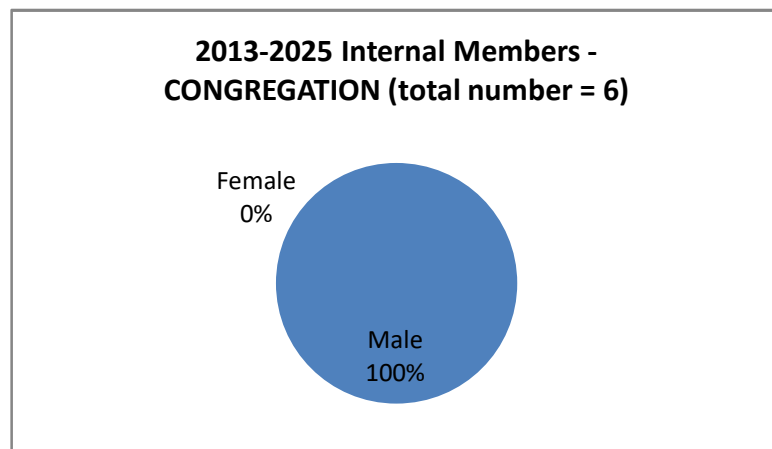

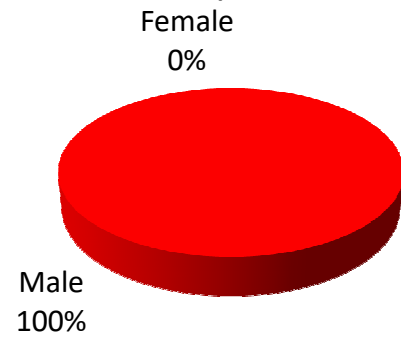
